



# Troost Bridge Replacement and Area Construction

## TROOST BRIDGE REPLACEMENT -- VOLKER / 49TH STREET / TROOST INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS -- TO CLOSE STREETS AND REROUTE TRAFFIC

Substantial infrastructure improvements planned for Troost Avenue between Emanuel Cleaver II Boulevard and 49th Street, and Volker Boulevard between The Paseo Boulevard and Rockhill Road will cause partial and full closure of streets for the next year.

**Volker Boulevard**, which has been reduced to two lanes since May 10, will remain partially closed until it is completely closed for two or three weeks yet this summer. During this closure, traffic will be detoured to Cleaver Boulevard via Troost or The Paseo

**Troost Avenue** is scheduled to be completely closed from Cleaver Boulevard to Volker Boulevard for ten days this summer. Permanent closure of the street until next fall is expected the first week of September. Only local traffic for the institutional buildings on those two blocks will be allowed on Troost from off of Cleaver Boulevard. The city will be rerouting traffic around the Troost Bridge via Rockhill Road or The Paseo.

The road closures accommodate the replacement of the Troost Bridge over Brush Creek, improvement of the Volker Boulevard/49th Street/Troost Avenue five-way intersection, separate a portion of the combined wastewater and stormwater sewers in this area, and improve pedestrian access. There are also plans to develop 47th Terrace east off Troost Avenue providing access into an area slated for commercial/retail redevelopment. Completion of the entire \$13.5 million infrastructure project is anticipated early 2012.

## Troost Avenue Bus Rapid Transit

**(BRT)** construction is continuing throughout the Troost corridor from downtown to 95th Street. Two MAX stations will be constructed immediately north of Cleaver Boulevard. New asphalt surfacing of Troost Avenue from 30th Street to 43rd Street is scheduled to begin August 9th. New sidewalk and streetscape improvements are scheduled at Brush Creek Boulevard and Troost Avenue in August and September. Troost MAX is scheduled to begin operations the end of October. When Troost Avenue between Cleaver Boulevard and Volker Boulevard is closed, buses along Troost Avenue will be rerouted to Rockhill Road between Cleaver Boulevard and 50th Street.
